

2023 Top US Cities FOR VETERAN ENTREPRENEURS







Methodology

Edelman Data & Intelligence collected a robust set of quantitative data from existing PenFed Foundation partners and openly available data sources to paint the full picture of veteran support, city characteristics and entrepreneurship ability across the US and rank US Metropolitan areas (MSAs) by these characteristics.

Using a custom scoring algorithm, DXI highlighted the MSAs that are the best places for Veteran Entrepreneurship.

10-15 Weighted factors in each category*

Normalized data to account for differences in data sources

Transformed data to eliminate bias within the data set

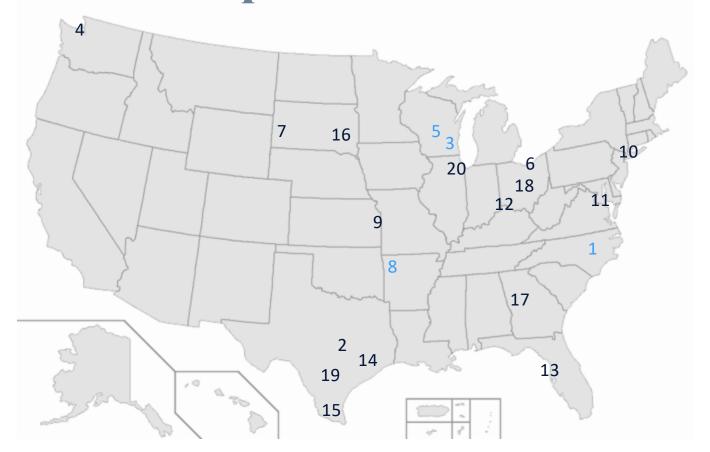

Living in a New Economic Reality

Post COVID and ongoing inflation has highlighted cities that faired well despite economic challenges



National median earnings decreased by 2.2%, Raleigh, NC median earnings increased by 32.3%



While national average childcare cost 34.1% of single parent median income, Arkansas averages the second lowest across the states at 27.4%



National regional price parities decreased by 0.02%, Austin-Round Rock regional price parities decreased by 1.72%



National average unemployment decreased by 3%, **Madison**, WI decreased by 12% (*resting at 2.2%*)



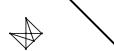
